



Foden/Weinmann: GP in Madona/LV

Solid ride

Dan Foden and Noah Weinmann had already faced their first challenge just getting to the GP in Madona, Latvia. The British-German duo had to cover a hefty 1800-kilometre journey to reach the Baltics. Their second challenge came from the demanding track. Under the surface of soft sand hard acceleration and braking edges formed already during practice.

„On this selective track, we really felt our lack of racing practice after the injury break,“ admitted driver Dan Foden after finishing eighth in the first race. Just a week ago, the team had made their comeback at the German GP race finishing fifth.

The duo showed an improving performance in the second race. After starting in the first third of the field, the team settled into sixth place. "The constant hits really took a toll on me. The pain was intense," explained passenger Noah Weinmann about his hand marked with burst blisters (photo below).

At least the shared ordeal moved the team from eighth to seventh in the World Championship standings. And: After the GP race, the winners of the first heat, local favourites Daniels and Bruno Lielbardis, invited their rivals to an after-race party in their hometown just 20 kilometres away.
