



No real progress on the Baltic Sea

Nothing is as old as yesterday's success. In sports, this realization often becomes a bitter reality. This is also true for the sidecar motocross riders Joshua and Noah Weinmann. While the duo could celebrate eleventh and seventh place finishes at the French World Championship race eight days ago, as well as a one-two finish in the Swiss Championship on Whit Monday, the cards were reshuffled last weekend.

"The track should have suited us," muses co-driver Noah about the course of the World Championship race in Poland. Indeed, tracks with hard, rutted clay surfaces are among the favorite terrains of the fit sidecar riders from the Weißbach district of Crispenhofen. The reasons why the 23- and 20-year-old brothers didn't find their footing at the "Tor motocrossowy Gdarisk" track, located just ten kilometers south of Gdansk, remain a mystery to the two Hohenlohe natives, even with the passage of time.

With two twelfth-place finishes, the off-roaders, who have recently enjoyed so much success, fell short of their personal goals. "The weather was perfect, we had acceptable starts, made no mistakes, and the sidecar ran superbly." "This time, I just wasn't up to the task in terms of driving," says driver Joshua, offering a simple yet honest explanation for their performance near the Baltic Sea. While these results would have been considered a successful World Championship weekend by the two students just a year ago, they do demonstrate the duo's positive development. However, they refuse to accept this downplaying of their achievements. And so, as they say, self-awareness is usually the first step to improvement.
