



### GP kickoff in Castelnau-de-Lévis/F

#### Promising start for Foden/Weinmann

The situation before the start of the Sidecarcross World Championship 2026 in Castelnau-de-Lévis was unusual for the Foden/Weinmann team. Five weeks ago, the British-German duo competed in only one pre-season race, and four weeks ago, rider Dan Foden injured his hand during practice. Three torn bones in his right wrist put further season preparation on hold. The World Championship opener in southern France was a cold start.

The record of driver Dan Foden remains positive nonetheless. “Even without practice we were able to nearly keep up with the speed of the best. Also my hand withstood the stress well”, summarized the 26-year-old. The perspective is also positive. On Wednesday (April 22), Foden/Weinmann will test their second newly built sidecar on the World Championship track in Rudersberg (near Stuttgart). Next weekend, the duo will continue honing their racing toughness at a German championship race close to Frankfurt.
