



Injury Update Dan Foden

Foden/Weinmann – Comeback in the planning?

Only four weeks have passed since Dan Foden's broken thumb was fixed with a plate and five screws by the renowned doctor Dr Claes in Herentals, Belgium, on 10 June. The driver of the Sidecar World Championship team Weinmann/Foden has also set a racing pace for his recovery. "I've spent many hours in the oxygen chamber, with laser therapy, and on the magnetic field mat. The bone should be okay," hopes the always highly motivated Brit. Already next Sunday, the 26-year-old wants to attempt a rollout with a local passenger at a regional competition. If the hand can handle the strain, a comeback at the World Championship race in Straßbessenbach (Germany) is planned.

Regular passenger Noah Weinmann is definitely ready. "During Dan's injury break, I increased my fitness training from one to two sessions a day," explains the 21-year-old from Germany. He even included new training methods like the currently popular heat training in professional sports (indoor cycling with winter clothing) in the blazing sun over the past few weeks.

Whether the British-German duo can actually make a comeback at the German World Championship race on 18/19 July will be revealed in the newsletter in the middle of next week.
