



Foden/Weinmann: GP in Anyksciai /LT

Bad news for Foden/Weinmann

Anyone following the career of the British-German sidecar team Foden/Weinmann currently finds themselves on an emotional rollercoaster, swinging between the World Championship squad's spectacular successes and devastating news about injuries. At the tenth round of the Sidecar World Championship in Anyksciai, Lithuania (100 kilometers north of Vilnius), negative news once again took center stage.

The first race had to be stopped early following a crash involving the English team Wilkinson/Millard. "After the restart, we were initially in eighth place and managed to work our way up the field bit by bit. That was okay," said rider Dan Foden, summing up their fifth-place finish in the first race with satisfaction.

However, the start of the second race undid the team's recent safety-conscious racing strategy. In the first, very fast left-hand corner, a rival sidecar clipped Foden and Weinmann's machine.

While rider Dan remained uninjured during the ensuing rollover, passenger Noah was taken to the hospital with a suspected spinal injury. Fortunately, examinations on Sunday evening revealed a concussion and a broken rib that had caused a minor lung injury.

Noah is due to undergo further checks for other injuries on Monday (August 3). If the doctors give the all-clear, he will be able to return home.

This newsletter will provide further updates on Noah's recovery and plans for a comeback—once again in the form of an injury report.
