Gespanncross-WM in Lommel/B



Joshua Weinmann seriously injured

Bad news from the Weinmann brothers. The two sidecar motocross riders suffered a serious crash at the fifth of nine World Championship meetings in Lommel, Belgium. After the start of the qualifying race on Saturday, the two riders from Hohenlohe touched a competitor on the approach to the second jump. Driver Joshua was thrown from his motorcycle and landed behind the jump. Several following sidecars were unable to avoid him and ran over the 23-year-old. The diagnosis: fractures of the sixth and seventh cervical vertebrae. Fortunately, there is no risk of paralysis. The 20-year-old passenger, Noah, was uninjured.

“We were able to quickly organize a rescue operation. Joshua will be flown back to Germany today (Sunday) and undergo surgery at the RKH Clinic in Ludwigsburg,” says father Thomas Weinmann, himself a 1995

Sidecar Motocross Vice World Champion. The motorsport community, and especially the Hohenlohe fans, wish Joshua a speedy recovery.
