



Double Victory and Top of the Championship

When things are going well, they're really going well – that's the simplest way to sum up the current success of brothers Joshua and Noah Weinmann. Just a week ago, the two sidecar motocross riders from Weißbach-Crispenhofen achieved their best World Championship result in Great Britain with two top-ten finishes (10th and 6th place). Last weekend, the challenge was to demonstrate the high level of performance the two Hohenlohe natives had already demonstrated on the international stage, also on the national level.

Indeed, the 23- and 20-year-old duo made their mark on the German Championship meeting in Schopfheim near Lörrach. "We knew that physical fitness would play a crucial role in the heat," predicted co-driver Noah before the two races. How right he was.

After starting in fifth position, the two drivers from the Kocher Valley steadily moved forward in the first of the two 30-minute races. Second place seemed to have achieved their first goal of the day. "But when we noticed that the leaders were slowing down, we got a taste for more," recalled driver Joshua towards the end of the race. In the final lap, the two students pulled off the decisive overtaking maneuver against their toughest rivals in the German Championship, Tim Prümmer from Aachen and his Dutch co-driver Aivar van de Wiel. The completely exhausted Dutchman collapsed after crossing the finish line and was unable to compete in the second race.

The physically fit "wine men" made short work of the 24 teams competing in the German Championship. From third place, the two stormed to the front after ten minutes on their 75 hp sidecar, securing the victory and thus the lead in the German Championship standings.
