

„Weinmänner“ defend their German Championship lead

One of the most important decisions in Jauer was made by the race doctor. With temperatures reaching 35 degrees Celsius in the shade, the two sidecar motocross races were shortened from 30 minutes to 25 minutes each. After all, the spectacular incidents in this physically demanding motorsport discipline are still fresh in everyone's minds. Just at the third German Championship race in Schopfheim at the beginning of June, Aivar van de Wiel, the Dutch passenger of top rider Tim Prümmer, collapsed after the first race.

„We often have bad starts, but we're always in good shape. That's why longer races are usually advantageous for us. But this time we're glad too,“ said passenger Noah, finding a silver lining in the race reduction. His brother Joshua had been weakened by a summer flu in Lusatia. „Even with the reduced distance, we had to pace ourselves to make it through the races,“ commented the 23-year-old rider on the unusual race strategy for the two athletes.

Ultimately, their restraint paid off. In both races, the two brothers moved up from fourth and fifth place to third, but then had to contend not only with pilot Joshua's ailing physical condition. „By the time we managed to break away from the pack, the leading duo had already pulled ten seconds ahead. There was nothing we could do,“ Joshua commented on their two third-place finishes.

It's understandable that the two riders from the Kocher Valley aren't entirely satisfied with two third-place finishes after their one-two finish at the last German Championship meeting in Schopfheim.

Nevertheless, the composed performances of the two students are proving worthwhile. This season, the duo has yet to experience a crash or a mechanical failure. This is an important foundation for remaining in contention for the German Championship title in the second half of the season.
